AP-001 Website Privacy

General Statement

Nipissing-Parry Sound Student Transportation Services (NPSSTS) is the transportation consortium for the following Member School Boards:

- Near North District School Board;
- Conseil scolaire catholique Franco-Nord;
- Nipissing-Parry Sound Catholic District School Board;
- Conseil scolaire publique du Nord-Est de l'Ontario.

In addition, the NPSSTS has contracts for the delivery of student transportation services with other agencies including First Nations and other School Boards. On behalf of these entities, NPSSTS organizes and administers all home to school student transportation.

NPSSTS is committed to respecting your privacy and protecting your personal information. This Privacy Statement explains the current information management practices on our website.

The handling of all personal information by NPSSTS is governed by the Municipal Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act (MFIPPA) and the Education Act.

Information Gathered

When you browse or download information from the NPSSTS website, our servers automatically collect limited amounts of standard information for traffic monitoring and statistical purposes. The information is analyzed for operational trends, performance and for ways to improve the site. Examples of this type of information include:

- Internet Protocol (IP) address of the computers being used;
- dates and times our site is accessed;
- types and versions of the browsers used to access our sites and the operating systems of the computers being used;
