SL – 006 Transportation of Co-Op Students		
General Statement	The Nipissing-Parry Sound Student Transportation Services (NPSSTS) will endeavour to accommodate requests for transportation for students in the Districts of Nipissing and Parry Sound involved in school-based cooperative education programs (Co-Op) with related placements off school grounds. Such accommodations will be made where feasible, provided there is no negative impact on other riders.	
Operational Procedure	The request for transportation to facilitate a co-op placement must come to the NPSSTS from the co-op teacher or other member of school staff who has access to the necessary details. These details include the location and the duration of the placement (i.e. number of weeks or end date) and whether transportation is requested for morning, afternoon, or both.
